PFC's Statement of Faith

Job Descriptions and Procedures: Bible Study Reviewers

Skills Needed: 1. A desire to serve, 2. Moderate knowledge of the Bible, 3. and a gift of caring and encouragement.

Time Estimated: 1-2 hours per week.

1. It is important to understand that the inmates who will be participating in this program come from varying degrees of educational and economic backgrounds. Some of the participants will have a good working knowledge of the Bible and others will not.
2. ***You will need to check your mail box at least weekly.*** You will have a green folder with your name on it at a central pick up point at your home church. Please discuss this with your team leader. **Also remember that the weekly turn around of these lessons is so important to the inmates. Please strive for a one week turnaround time.** If for some reason you can't grade your lessons or you will be out of town on vacation, please let your team leader know ahead of time so they can make arrangements to get the lessons graded and keep the lessons flowing.
3. Always make your comments in *ink* that will stand out, never in pencil. Please never use a red ink pen as that may bring flashbacks of bad experiences from childhood school. Also never assign a letter grade.
4. Feel free to sign your firstname only. Never use your last name. If you have a unique first name you will need to sign your initials.
5. All mail and lessons are funneled through the PFC offices. Never use your full name and never use your home address for any communications with your students!!!!
6. It is often characteristic for beginning reviewers to use one word responses like: "Good," or "Excellent Answer," "Right On." For a season of time for the beginning reviewer in learning how to grade lessons, this is ok. However, we want all of our reviewers to take their grading to the next level of leadership. This will entail becoming involved with giving constructive input to their students assignments and making it personal. If you should have questions on properly graded lessons please feel free to consult your team leaders as most will have samples of correctly graded lessons.
7. 80 % of the inmates have an extremely poor self image of themselves. Therefore, we always encourage them as much as possible. However, if their answers are obviously theologically wrong, please gently steer them to proper scripture reference with a positive correct answer.
8. These Bible Study Lessons were designed to instruct and to encourage the inmate to **apply** the scripture application in their daily walk with the Lord and not just to give factual answers. Keep this in mind when grading their lessons.
9. Establishing a pen pal relationship with an inmate is beyond the scope of this job description. Often a lengthy letter is attached with the returned Bible Study Lesson. However, if you are feeling led to write to an inmate, please consult with the PFC Pen Pal Coordinator or your team leader for further pen pal training.
10. No items, whatsoever, are to be sent to inmates. Everything is considered contraband. **This Is The Only Rule That Is Punishable By Fine And/Or Imprisonment!!!**
11. Remember your mission is to share Jesus Christ. Many inmates are lonely people, and it is easy for them to respond to Christian kindness in the wrong way. If your intentions are made clear from the start, you will be able to avoid misunderstandings.
12. Stick with it, constantly pray for the discernment of the Holy Spirit, and above all--Be A Friend! **Remember You Are Ambassadors Of Christ.**
